The Boone County Commission met in REGULAR SESSION on Tuesday, May 15, 2018. Those present for the meeting were Commission President Eddie Hendricks, Commissioner Mickey Brown and Commissioner Craig Bratcher. Staff present was Pam White, Administrator, and Lee Ann Dale, Assistant Administrator.

This meeting was recorded on CD 485. Commissioner Hendricks ask if there were any objections to the agenda and called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

At Track 1 on CD, Commissioner Brown made a motion to approve the Exonerations as prepared and presented by the Assessor's Office, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 1 on CD, Commissioner Bratcher made a motion to approve the Minutes from the May 1, 2018, Regular Meeting, seconded by Commissioner Brown, motion passed.

Track 2 on CD, Commissioner Brown made a motion to approve the County Clerk's Appointments and Finals as presented by the County Clerk's Office, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 2 on CD, John Abbott and Mark Snow, spoke to the Commission regarding an abandoned building in the Town of Danville.

At Track 13 on CD, Toby Waller, Boone County Public Service District, updated the Commission on both the Morrisvale and Prenter Water Projects.

At Track 22 on CD, Commissioner Brown made a motion to approve to commit the remaining \$238,250.00 funds for the Prenter Phase II Waterline Extension Project, and further authorizes its President, Eddie Hendricks, to sign on its behalf, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 37 on CD, Commissioner Brown made a motion to approve the request of Scotty D. Cook, Assessor, to hire one position for part-time, at the rate of \$10.50 per hour, following a pre-employment drug screen, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 38 on CD, Commissioner Brown made a motion to approve the request of Roger Toney, County Clerk, to purchase a receipt validator printer from CSSI, in the amount of \$720.00, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 42 on CD, Commissioner Brown made a motion to approve the annual maintenance agreement with Zuercher/EmergiTech, Inc., in the amount of \$37,016.64, as requested by Greg Lay, Emergency Management Director, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 45 on CD, Commission Bratcher made a motion to approve to proclaim May 20, 2018, through May 26, 2018, as Community Educational Outreach Service Week (CEOS), seconded by Commissioner Brown, motion passed.

At Track 48 on CD, Commissioner Brown made a motion to reappoint Eddie Hendricks to the Boone County Historic Landmark Commission, serving a one year term, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 49 on CD, Commissioner Brown made a motion to reappoint Chad Toney to the Boone County Parks and Recreation Commission, serving a three year term, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 50 on CD, Commissioner Brown made a motion to approve to pay the bills as presented, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 50 on CD, Commissioner Bratcher made a motion to approve the Purchase Orders as prepared and presented, seconded by Commissioner Brown, motion passed.
