The Boone County Commission met on Tuesday, May 5, 2020, in REGULAR SESSION, VIA VIRTUAL TELEPHONE CONFERENCE, due to the COVID-19 mandated social distancing. Those attending the meeting via telephone conference were Commission President Eddie Hendricks, Commissioner Craig Bratcher and Commissioner Brett Kuhn. Staff present was Pam White, Administrator, and Lee Ann Dale, Assistant Administrator.

This meeting was recorded on CD 566. Commission President Eddie Hendricks called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

At Track 1 on CD, Commissioner Bratcher made a motion to approve the Exonerations as prepared and presented by the Assessor's Office, seconded by Commissioner Kuhn, motion passed.

At Track 1 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve the Minutes from the April 21, 2020, Virtual Meeting, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 2 on CD, Commissioner Bratcher made a motion to approve the County Clerk's Appointments and Finals as presented by the County Clerk's Office, seconded by Commissioner Kuhn, motion passed.

At Track 31 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve to create Fund #206 titled "COVID-19" in the amount of \$100,000.00, to accurately track all revenues and expenses related to the pandemic, as instructed by the West Virginia State Auditor's Office, seconded by Commissioner Bratcher, motion passed.

At Track 33 on CD, the Courthouse reopening plans for May 18, 2020, was discussed by the Commission and Elected Officials.

At Track 43 on CD, Commissioner Bratcher made a motion to pay the amount of \$18,953.64, to the WV Municipal Bond Commission on behalf of the Boone Raleigh Public Service District, for April and May bond payments, seconded by Commissioner Kuhn, motion passed.
