The Boone County Commission met in REGULAR SESSION on Tuesday, February 16, 2021. Those present for the meeting were Commission President, Craig Bratcher, Commissioner Brett Kuhn and Commissioner Jacob Messer. Staff present were Pam White, Administrator, and Lee Ann Dale, Assistant Administrator.

This meeting was recorded on CD 593. Commission President, Craig Bratcher called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

At Track 2 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve the Exonerations as prepared and presented by the Assessor's Office, seconded by Commissioner Messer, motion passed.

At Track 2 on CD, Commissioner Messer made a motion to approve the Minutes from the February 2, 2021, Regular Meeting, seconded by Commissioner Kuhn, motion passed.

At Track 2 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve the County Clerk's Appointments and Finals as presented by the County Clerk's Office, seconded by Commissioner Messer, motion passed.

At Track 48 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve to sign the 2021-2020 Memorandum of Understanding Agreement with the Southwestern Regional Day Report Center, to provide 30% match for the 2021-2022 grant year, seconded by Commissioner Messer, motion passed.

At Track 50 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve a contribution to the Bituminous Coal Heritage Museum, in the amount of \$2,500.00, paid from the reallocated coal severance fund, to assist in utilities and insurance, seconded by Commissioner Messer, motion passed.
