The Boone County Commission met in REGULAR SESSION on Tuesday, May 25, 2021. Those present for the meeting were Commission President, Craig Bratcher, Commissioner Brett Kuhn and Commissioner Jacob Messer. Staff present were Pam White, Administrator, and Lee Ann Dale, Assistant Administrator.

This meeting was recorded on CD 604. Commission President, Craig Bratcher called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

At Track 1 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve the Exonerations as prepared and presented by the Assessor's Office, seconded by Commissioner Messer, motion passed.

At Track 1 on CD, Commissioner Messer made a motion to approve the Minutes from the May 18, 2021, Regular Meeting, seconded by Commissioner Kuhn, motion passed.
