The Boone County Commission met in REGULAR SESSION on Tuesday, December 7, 2021. Those present for the meeting were Commission President, Craig Bratcher, Commissioner Brett Kuhn and Commissioner Jacob Messer. Staff present were Pam White, Administrator, and Lee Ann Dale, Assistant Administrator.

This meeting was recorded on CD 625A and 625B. Commission President, Craig Bratcher called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

At Track 1 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve the Exonerations as prepared and presented by the Assessor's Office, seconded by Commissioner Messer, motion passed.

At Track 1 on CD, Commissioner Messer made a motion to approve the Minutes from the November 30, 2021, Regular Meeting, seconded by Commissioner Kuhn, motion passed.

At Track 2 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve the County Clerk's Appointments and Finals as presented by the County Clerk's Office, seconded by Commissioner Messer, motion passed.

At Track 2 on CD, Commission President, Craig Bratcher, ask for any public comments.

At Track 2 on CD, Terry Moran, PSD Engineer, open bids for the Boone Memorial Hospital sewer project on the former Magic Mart property. The only bid received was from Carpenter Reclamation, in the amount of \$529,225.00.

At Track 19 on CD, Commissioner Messer made a motion to approve the request of Michael Mayhorn, Boone County Emergency Management Director, to sign the 2019 Emergency Management Performance Grant application, in the amount of \$25,000.00, for reimbursement of salaries, and further authorizes the Commission President, Craig Bratcher, to sing on its behalf, seconded by Commissioner Kuhn, motion passed.

At Track 22 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to approve the request of Michael Mayhorn, Boone County Emergency Management Director, to sign the 2020 Emergency Management Performance Grant application, in the amount of \$12,500.00, for reimbursement of 2 message boards, and further authorizes the Commission President, Craig Bratcher, to sing on its behalf, seconded by Commissioner Messer, motion passed.

At Track 28 on CD, Commissioner Kuhn made a motion to sign the letter requesting an extension of the 18th Cycle Courthouse Facilities Improvement Grant, and further authorizes the Commission President, Craig Bratcher, to sing on its behalf, seconded by Commissioner Messer, motion passed.
